- To win the World Series you must win 4 games.
- The World Series has been going on since 1903.
- The first game to ever be played at night in the World Series was in 1971.

- The World Series is also known as the Fall Classic.
- The World Series is played between the American League and the National League.
- The American League has won 62 World Series, and the National League has won 46.

# Cardinals World Series

- The Cardinals have been to the World Series 18 times.
- They have won the World Series 11 times.
- This is the fourth time to play against the Red Sox.
- The Cardinals have now played the Red Sox in the World Series 4 times.

- The Cardinals have defeated the Red Sox in the World Series 2 times.
- The Cardinals first World Series wasn't until 1926.
- Cardinals have the second most World Series wins.

- ❑ There is a rivalry with the Cardinals and the Red Sox.

# Red Sox take a 2nd victory

After playing seven games, the Boston Red Sox won game six with the score of 6-1. This makes the Red Sox tied with the Cardinals in wins for World Series titles, being 2-2.

# Cardinals take another defeat

After meeting each other in the World Series for the fourth time, the Red Sox take the second win over the Cardinals. The Red Sox won in 2004, which was the last time Cardinals and Red Sox played each other in the World Series, and have now won the 2013 World Series as well.

# Interesting Facts

- This is the first World Series for Boston to win at home since 1918.
- The Red Sox all had some type of facial hair, they started growing their facial hair during spring training.
- The prices for game six were \$2,189-\$774 and the lowest (\$774) was standing room only.

- This was the first World Series since 1999 that both teams that played in the World Series have the two best regular-season records.
- 76 million people were watching when game 3 went into extra innings.

# World Series 2014

The odds for the 2014 World Series say that the Los Angeles Dodgers will win the World Series title. Boston Red Sox are ranked fourth, with the Cardinals right behind them ranked fifth.



# World Series 2012

The 2012 World Series was played by the San Francisco Giants, and the Detroit Tigers. The Giants won four games in a row, making themselves the 2012 winners of the World Series.



# John Farrell



John Farrell is the Boston Red Sox manager. He is a former MLB pitcher, and was also a pitching coach for the Red Sox from 2007-2010. He was the manager for the Toronto Blue Jays from 2011-2012.

# Mike Matheny

Mike Matheny is the St. Louis Cardinals manager. He is a former MLB catcher. His baseball career lasted thirteen years, and he played for four different teams. He won four National League Gold Glove Awards, and was considered the best catcher in his era.



# World Series

There has only been one team to never win, the San Diego Padres, who have made only 2 appearances in the World Series. The World Series has been played since 1903, there have been 108 World Series, and hope to be many more.
